The FCC 740 is required for radio frequency devices such as (but not limited to) communication devices (i.e., transmitters, receivers, computers, cash registers, and telephones). This form must be filed for each shipment and for each type of R.F. device imported. This form is no longer required for components and subassemblies so long as the devices do not constitute an essentially completed device.

PART I: ALL BLOCKS MUST BE COMPLETED.

Date of Entry - Broker will complete at the time of entry.

Entry Number - Broker will complete at the time of entry.

Port of Entry - Broker will complete at the time of entry.

Harmonized Number - H.S. tariff number that most closely describes the product.

Quantity of Item (Not number of containers) - Number of unit pieces, not packages.

Device Model/Type Name or # - If the articles shipped have a model or type number, this must be completed.

Trade Name - If the articles shipped have a specific trade name, it must be noted here. (This is NOT necessarily the manufacturer's name).

FCC Identifier - Number assigned by FCC to the device when considered Class B. This number is on a tag or sticker affixed to device. (Number is NOT required if Class A, such as TV's).

Description of Equipment - Generic description of the equipment such as "FM transmitters."

Manufacturer's Name and Address - The actual manufacturer of the product.

Consignee's Name and Address - The name and address where the goods are to be delivered rather than a freight forwarder.

Importer's Name and Address - The name and address of the party responsible for the payment of duty (if any) and brokerage.

Printed or Typed Name of Importer or Consignee - The printed name of the signing party.

Printed or Typed Name of Importer or Consignee - The printed name of the signing party.

Signature of Importer or Consignee - The signature of the party who is responsible for payment of duty (if any) and brokerage. A party knowledgeable of the facts must sign the FCC 740 form. As PBB USA, Inc. is not such a party, we cannot sign this form.

Date - Date that the document is signed.
