Canada Customs and Revenue Agency may authorize certain importers to maintain records outside Canada provided they submit this "letter of undertaking". The purpose of this document is to record and set out the agreement made between the company and Canada Customs and Revenue Agency, concerning the availability of Customs records for audit purposes.

This document must be completed **in full** with complete <u>business address where the books are maintained</u> (no post office box numbers) and if applicable, the corresponding mailing address of the company. The Business Number issued to your company must also be indicated. Incomplete forms will be returned for proper completion.

Please note that **two** officers of the company must sign this document. If only one officer is available, the corporate seal must be endorsed on the form.
